Title:

Promoting UDL principles and strategies for inclusive learning: The Redesigning Blended Courses Project at the University of Cape Town

Description:

Strategically aligned to the university's Vision 2030 of creating digitally-enabled education, an intended outcome of the Redesigning Blended Courses Project is to develop models for blended learning that can improve students' learning and success.

Mindful of the bruising experience of emergency remote teaching during the pandemic which exposed the deep inequalities of our context, our project aims to offer support for the development of courses that effectively integrate in-person and online modes of instruction for a more inclusive and active student learning experience.

Incorporating the three principles of Universal Design for Learning (UDL) into the design of blended courses provides a framework to move us away from a deficit model of seeing certain groups of students as requiring accommodations, and moves us toward a more equitable model where inclusion in course design is an upfront principle.

In this webinar, we will briefly describe our context (including the legacy of racial oppression, urgent agenda for decolonising the curriculum, and impacts of the emergency pivot to remote learning), and will elaborate on our project goals, sharing our initial progress.
